Objective: To prepare the participants to reduce injury and facilitate transport of cryonics patients in emergency and non-emergency situations

Topics: Ischemic injury and other forms of damage
Treatments prior to cardiac arrest
Medications of benefit after cardiac arrest
CardioPulmonary Support with limited resources
Cooling methods
Hands-on familiarization with stabilization equipment
Monitoring vital signs
Assisting funeral directors, physicians, nurses and hospital staff
Hospice care
Shipping issues
Avoiding infection

Class size limited to 15 participants

Priority given to participants in the following order: (1) CI Members with funding and contracts (2) Other CI Members (3) Family and friends of CI Members having funding and contracts (4) Members of other cryonics organizations (5) General public.

Before April 15, 2008 only CI Members with funding and contracts will be guaranteed a position. All others will be placed on a waiting list. The class list will be completed in the order shown on April 15.

There is no charge for attending the training, there is only a charge for those who say they will attend and do not do so.
